They also have a stronger scent than paraffin and clean up better (soap and hot water). We have lots of different scents from Macintosh to Green Tea to Honeysuckle. Email me to get the most current list. Everyone who has tried the candles have given us a great review. Also, you can actually use the liquefied wax as a moisturizer on your dry skin. It's not like paraffin yet it's not greasy either. It's absorbed evenly and you smell great. 8oz jar: 1 for \$5, 2 for \$8 This size burns for 70-80 hours when the wick is properly trimmed.
